**Qualifications** for this role include:

- B. Arch, M.Arch, or other relevant design degree. Registration with OAA or equivalent regulatory body (as Intern) is an asset.
- 1+ years of relevant experience in a design role is required. Experience in institutional work or other large-scale, complex projects is preferred.
- Experience in multiple (but not necessarily all) phases of architectural design. Phases include concept development and planning, schematic design, design development, and construction documents.
- Competent skills in architectural representation, including but not limited to plans, sections, elevations, 3d models, renderings, and explanatory diagrams.
- Revit skills are required. Proficiency in CAD and other pertinent software including Sketchup, Photoshop, Illustrator, and MS Office are also valuable.
- Foundational knowledge of building materials, specifications, and construction techniques.
- Foundational knowledge of sustainable design approaches.
- Clearance through Contract Security Program is an asset.

**Characteristics** that define a successful member of the MTA team include:

- Self-motivation with strong organizational skills and good problem-solving ability.
- Willingness and ability to take instruction and guidance from senior team members and to contribute individual efforts to broader team objectives.
